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### Access Rules Cisco

An access rule permits or denies traffic based on the protocol, a source and destination IP address or network, and optionally the source and destination ports. For transparent mode only, an EtherType rule controls network access for non-IP traffic. An EtherType rule permits or denies traffic based on the EtherType.

Access rules determine which traffic is allowed through the ASA. There are several different layers of rules that work together to implement your access control policy: Extended access rules (Layer 3+ traffic) assigned to interfaces—You can apply separate rule sets (ACLs) in the inbound and outbound directions.

### RV260 Port Forwarding overrides Access Rules - Cisco

The ACL Manager page will show all existing ACLs, whereas the Access Rules page will only show you the ACLs that have been applied to interfaces. ACLs can be used for more than just traffic filtering, so if you're trying to wrap your head around the existing ruleset, it's probably best to focus your

attention to the Access Rules page for now.

### **Clarification about Difference between Access Rules and ...**

Next I created Access rules (The first rule is priority 1, the last is priority 4): 1. ALLOW FTP from WAN1 to ANY source 2. ALLOW HTTP from WAN1 to ANY source 3. ALLOW HTTPS from WAN1 to ANY source 4. DENY ALL traffic from WAN1 to a RANGE of 192.168.x.84 through 192.168.x.87

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
