Fining: Removing specific compounds — like excess tannins — from wine with a specialized fining agent. Malolactic fermentation: Optional process in which bacteria turn malic acid into lactic acid, softening wine. Mouthfeel: Texture of a wine in the mouth, different from aroma and flavor, but just as important. Must: Juice, with or without skins, pulp, and seeds, ready for fermentation.
